Daily-Light and Love

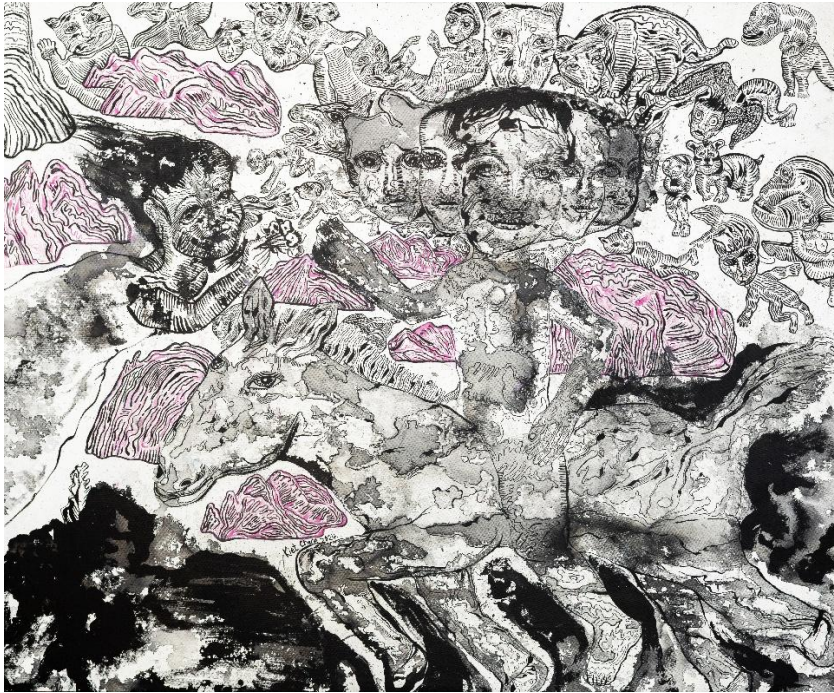

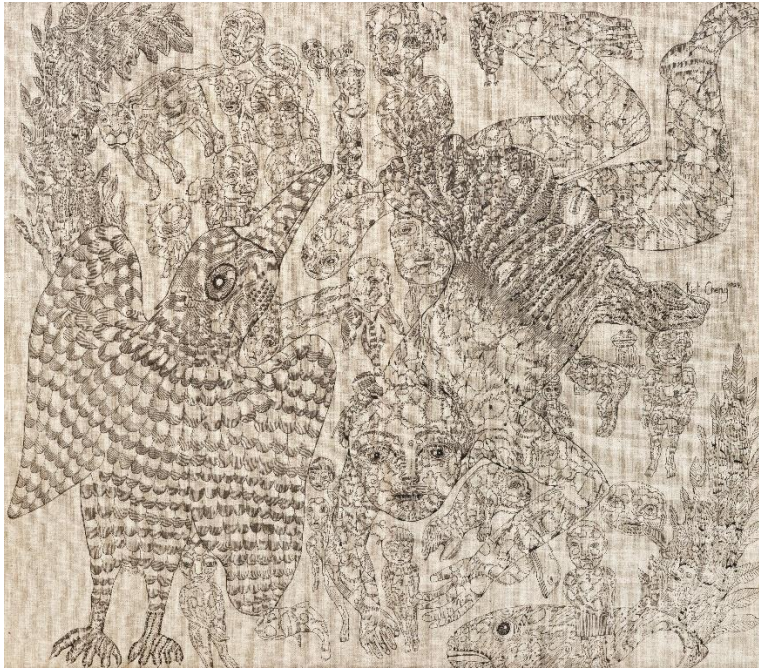

Since having children, my savings have been slipping away like a walking fish. Yet I must continue working hard and preparing for our future.



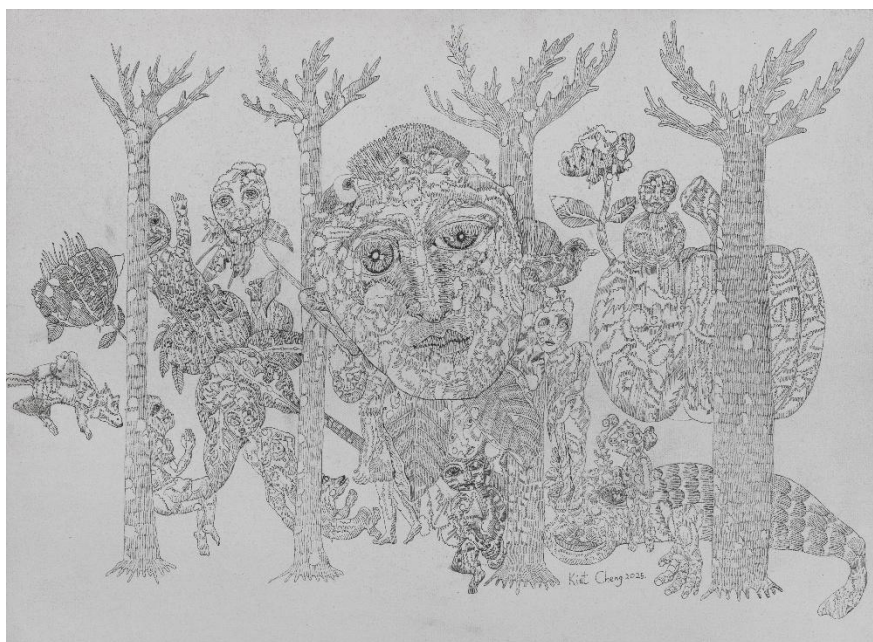
Hugging by a tree

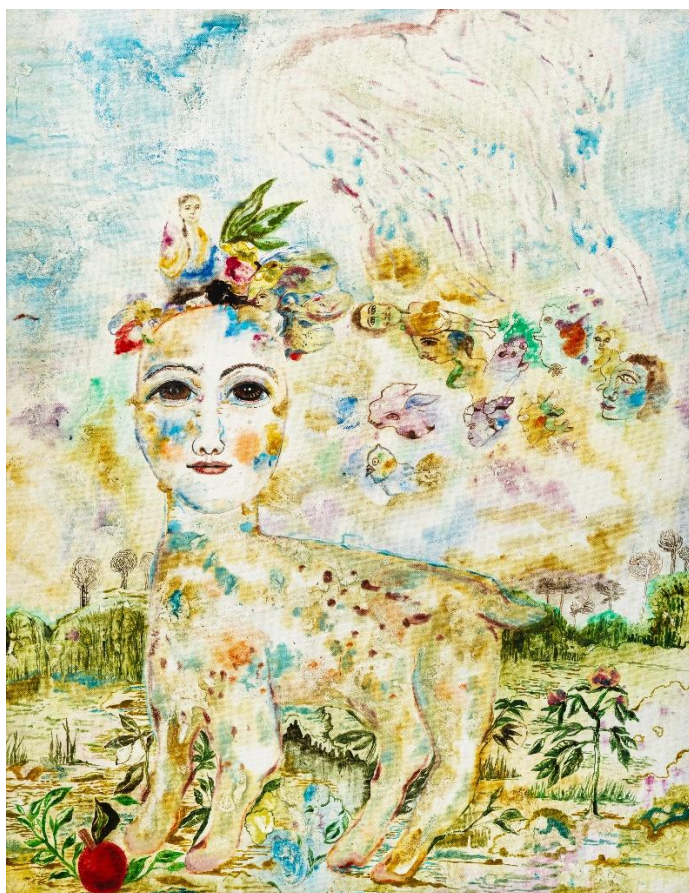
Celebration in the forest
